How to protect yourself from fraud

Your safety is our top priority. Unfortunately, scammers repeatedly try to impersonate official representatives of financial platforms – including justETF – by creating fake accounts. Here you can find out what to look out for, how to protect yourself, how to recognize us and how to contact us.

Important Notes

No communication via WhatsApp or private channels

We **never** communicate via WhatsApp, Telegram or similar messenger services. If someone writes to you and claims to be from justETF – please be careful, these are highly likely to be scammers.

We never ask you for money

justETF will **never ask you directly for money transfers, account details or credit card information**. Our platform is exclusively for information purposes – you cannot invest money with us.

No investment advice

We do not provide **individual investment recommendations**. Our content is for general information purposes only and does not replace personal advice. Therefore, you will never receive messages from us offering you personal advice or similar. In general, you should be careful if someone offers you financial advice on social media.

We are not active in any investment groups

justETF does not run **any crypto, stock or other investment groups**. Neither on Telegram, WhatsApp or other messenger platforms, nor on social media. If someone approaches you there with investment offers, it is **not** us.
